

## **MCPA 2012-2013 Student Scholarship**

The Michigan Career Placement Association (MCPA) works to improve career preparation for students by providing services to professionals involved in the placement of students into work-based learning experiences. MCPA has established a scholarship to recognize and reward an outstanding senior who has made extraordinary efforts and realized success in his/her work-based learning placement. The student may use the scholarship for tuition, fees, books, or career-related supplies.

### **Eligibility:**

A senior who is eligible for graduation that is currently enrolled in a work-based learning experience and has a placement related to their EDP career pathway.

### **Application Procedures:**

Complete the application on the following page and mail it along with the following items:

- Resume
- Reference page listing a minimum of three references
- EDP
- Official transcript including 1<sup>st</sup> semester grades from senior year
- Current schedule
- One page essay that discusses student's participation in a work-based learning experience. The student should detail in this essay how he/she has made extraordinary efforts in his/her placement and the success they have realized through this participation.
- Letter of recommendation from his/her work-based learning employer/supervisor

All of the above information should be submitted to your MCPA Regional Representative by April 15. Please refer to page three of this application for Regional Rep contact information. Each region will pick one applicant to submit to the MCPA Executive Board. The Board will determine one recipient for the State.
